INTRODUCING FRODO & GORD

Frodo the Sheltie is an online strip, about a Shetland sheepdog living in a big city without any sheep in sight. What's a shepherd to do? Canadian cartoonist, Gordon Bagshaw (born October 27, 1968) illustrates the off-the-wall antics of this lovable character, which is based on his real life sheltie.

Gord grew up in Montreal, Canada. Being unable to participate in common sports, due to a mild form of Nemaline Myopathy, he honed in on other various skills in art and music. As a child, having a gifted storyteller for a father, he developed his own vivid imagination and gravitated towards the talent of cartooning at a young age. Besides graduating with honours in Creative Arts with an emphasis in film and animation, Gord went on to theological studies and serviced as a youth minister for 12 years in the Anglican Church of Canada.

Today, he lives in São Paulo, Brazil, where he teaches English as a second language, preparing adult learners for travel, work and continued education.

In 2010, he and his wife, Raquel, bought a sheltie pup, which has brought a tremendous amount of joy into their lives. The little guy's name is Frodo. As so many pet owners can relate, a playful and affectionate bond developed, as well as comical stories. It was in the beginning of 2011 that Gord began to write what he entitled, "Conversations with Frodo" and "Frodo Quotes" on his personal Facebook Page. They were amusing little anecdotes with the slight twist that Frodo could actually speak. Although it began just as a simple pleasure to share a laugh with close friends, it unexpectedly found an increasing group of followers. It wasn't until the end of October 2012 that Frodo the Sheltie made its' debut as a full-colour strip. Now, just under 5 months old, the strip already has a rapidly growing audience stretching over 20 countries worldwide.

Gord is pleased to join the team of contributors for the Global Shelties Magazine; adding exclusive Frodo the Sheltie cartoon strips for the quarterly publications. It is his hope that GSM subscribers will enjoy viewing as much as he does creating.

To make this even better Zen also had a son Zev competing in championships with another handler! So mother, daughter and son competing together at the most prestigious Crufts agility championship! To make the day even more perfect, both Zaz and Zen qualified for the finals which happened right before the Groups and Best In Show.

Zen is 10 years old and is now retired after running at her last Crufts. She won runner-up in the Medium ABC final on Friday beating out many younger dogs. She is being retired while she is still fit and running at the top. Her daughter Zaz won the Small Agility Championship Final on Sunday and this is the second year in a row that she is crowned **Crufts Agility Champion**.

This is my daughter Emma Pirrie with Pearl the Sheltie. (Registered name: Shayla String of Pearls). Emma is 12 years old, and this was her third time at Crufts but first time in the 12 and over section and first time with Pearl. (She also has a Border Terrier who was competing for the third time and was part of the Winning YKC Agility Team of the Year). Pearl is two years old and she has only had one season competing. She was the youngest dog in the final, and because she has so little experience we were over the moon with her performance. To get to the semi final of the Young Kennel Club Agility Dog of the Year (YKC ADOTY) at Crufts you need to qualify during the year. Pearl qualified at the Scottish Kennel Club in August. The first three in every section at Crufts in the YKC ring go through to a final in the main arena. The final is against all dog sizes and all age groups. Emma was third in semi group over 12 size medium. When she went into final Emma was very nervous and so was Pearl. There were people moving about in front seats while she was running and she was spooked a bit, but it's all in the learning and it's very different to what she is used to when competing. We can't wait until next year. Two Border Collies were first and second in final! Pearl is just a baby in agility terms and competes at grade 4.

Collage Day Visit

My dog training class got a second invitation to bring our canines to visit the campus at Westfield State University in Westfield, Massachusetts, USA.

The objective was to give the students a break from studying for their finals by relaxing, petting and being around the dogs. The dogs from the class are a variety of purebreds and mixed breeds and the invitation was open to any of us who had the time and felt their dogs trustworthy enough to take to the event. The dogs and owners were familiar with each other from the times spent in the training class together. We were to meet and be available in the area of the library and notices were posted that we were coming.



I brought four Shelties with me, a blue merle male, a black & white female a blue & white male and a 5 month old sable puppy. Just getting across the campus from the parking area with my four was difficult as I was stopped constantly by the students. A big hit was a young, but fully grown Great Dane who also came.

The students were very good with the dogs. In my case they sat on the floor and formed a ring where my Shelties were free to go from one to another to meet, greet, get pats and were enticed to crawl up into laps! The puppy actually outlasted the older dogs with the excitement of meeting all these new and interesting people. Many of the students mentioned how much they missed their own dogs. Other's asked questions about colors, age, training, and/or breed.

It gave us a chance to speak to them about some of the Animal Activists actions as well. None of the dogs were/are certified therapy dogs but they were still able to give the students some comfort and general therapy just by being there. It was a pleasure for the owner's to be able to present our dogs in such a fashion. The college official who arranged it all also had a volunteer sign-up sheet and/or donation jar available for the benefit of the local shelter.

It was a win-win situation for all.




