

This article continues the history of Shetland Sheepdogs in Australia and from previous articles that have been published in earlier United Sheltie Magazines.

Over the years many Shelties have been imported into Australia mainly from the United Kingdom and New Zealand and in more recent times from the United States of America, Canada, Europe and Japan.

Since the arrival of the first American bred Sheltie import to gain the Australian Title **Au/Am Ch Kensil's Dreams 'N Schemes (Imp USA>Aust) (ROMA)** a large number of imports have arrived, some of these include



INTERESTING HISTORY

Australia

Under the photo is written:

"BLAIZE and CORRIE, two Shetland Collies from Kent (Eng) consigned to Miss Joy Elser, of Carnegie, arrived yesterday in the port of Wyndham. Here they are being exercised on the deck by Cadet A. Lyne. They are the first of their breed to come to Australia."

And on the opposite page:

"Dog Pioneers"

"The first of our breed to come to Australia were the two Shetland Sheepdogs, Claudas of Cameliard, and Riverhill Regal about late 1939 or in 1937.

Claudus of Cameliard, "Corrie" was a Sable dog, born 26. 7. 35. His sire was Eng. Ch Gawaine of Cameliard, and his dam was Eng. Ch. Mary of Camevock.

Riverhill Regal "Blaize" was a Tri colour bitch, born 4-10- 33. Her Sire was Eng. Ch. Tillford Tweed, and her dam was Kilda of Clerwood.

Two known litters were produced under the Oakdale prefix, of the late Miss Joy Esler. They were Oakdale Diedre, born 1st Jan 1938, and Oakdale Leonore, born 15th Mar 1939

The above four dogs were entered in the 1939 Melbourne Royal show. Regretfully these all died out, and the breed did not become established until the late 1950's in other States, and approximately 1960 in Victoria.

Since then the breed's popularity has increased to its present stage".



Pat Ferrell (ASSA Breed Historian) writes:

"I've driven up there myself. I think it was last year or the year before, just to see where it was. It was after I was "talking" with the grandsons so much anyway. Trees are bigger now, not such a "clear view" of the surrounding hills. I'd gotten some directions from the grandson on how to find it. For the time it took me to get there on "modern roads" I can imagine the drive it was for the ASSA people who went up there in the past to visit there before those roads were available.


There is a mention in some places about the dirt roads etc. which are all paved now and I-91 can be taken for some distance before getting off on smaller, state highways.

The property only left the Gallagher family somewhat recently, a year or two before they'd given the ASSA trophies to me for the ASSA archives. I didn't stop in, but just drove by a time or two.

Page's Hill itself, from which the kennel name was taken, had been a ski slope (small one with a tow rope) at one time and a few relics of that time still exist, or so the grandson's told me.

Has or was perhaps to get some type of historical classification I believe. From what I can remember it was one of the first places to have a mechanical means to "tow" people back up to the top of the ski slope.


